Review of minutes from meeting on October 21, 2018

- Angela King gave an update on the process for obtaining 501c3 status. We agreed that it would be beneficial and she would start the process by the end of the first week in December.
- There is a \$575 fee to get the process started with Taxcorp which will be paid out of the OAAAA account.
- The process takes around 30 days.
- A motion was carried to start the process of obtaining 501c3 status.
- Board members were asked to provide legal name and social security number.
- After filing for 501c3 status records will have to be kept for 6 years and anyone can see the books at any time.
- Jarrod Patterson met with former president Everett Roper to sign over access to the business account.
- There was currently \$1100 in the account but that would drop to around 750-800 after a vendor cashed a check.
- A meeting was scheduled for December 16, 2018 to discuss the Constitution and Bylaws.
- Plans were made for Giving Tuesday. For a 24 hour period alumni and supporters will be encouraged to donate to the OAAAA. An amount of \$50 minimum will be encouraged.
- Jarrod distributed a sample script and encouraged everyone to participate via social media.
- The next fundraiser will be the buy a brick campaign which will be ongoing.
- The goal is 400 bricks.
- The Alumni Weekend luncheon will be in the Family Life Center gym.
- Catering cost and venue setup will be considered.
- Tickets for the luncheon will be online.
- Around 300 tickets were sold last year.
- The menu will be decided at a forth-coming meeting.
- Angela King will create a bid for the catering job.
